- 3. As the tea plantation industry is seasonal in nature and dependent on rainfall, the financials of the current quarter are not readily comparable with corresponding previous/preceding quarter/year.
- 4. The Board of Directors has recommended a final dividend of Rs1.70 per share (17%) and a centenary year dividend of Re.1.00 per share (10%) which together with an interim dividend of Re.1/- per share (10%) already paid, aggregates to Rs.3.70 per share (37%) for the year ended 31st March 2022. The proposed dividend when approved by the shareholders will be met out of surplus in the retained earnings.
- 5. The figures of last quarter(s) are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year(s) and published figures upto the quarter ended 31st December of the current and previous period.
- 6. The Company's main business of tea plantation has not been impacted by covid-19 disruptions during the year ended 31st March 2022 and also for the year ended 31st March 2021. However, the income from let out property during the quarter and year ended 31st March 2021 was affected due to covid 19 disruptions to the tune of Rs. 2.64 lakhs and Rs. 61.69 lakhs respectively.
- 7. Previous period(s) figures have been re-grouped / reclassified wherever necessary.

## **Basis of Opinion**

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under Section 143(10) of the Act. Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the 'Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Annual Financial Results' section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India ("ICAI") together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the Provisions of the Act and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the ICAI's Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

#### Management's Responsibilities for the Financial Results

These annual Financial Results have been prepared on the basis of the Annual Financial Statements. The Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these financial results that give a true and fair view of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. The Board of Directors of the Company are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the Financial Results, the Board of Directors of the Company are responsible for assessing the ability of the Company to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.
